On the day that you are volunteering please know what you are doing and what pack you are from before coming. This information is available from your Pack Coordinator. Please arrive and check in prior to your start time (Station Leaders 8:00 am and Walking Leaders 8:30 am). Check in at Headquarters (Trailer) to sign in, to get your identification for the day, and to review your assignment location. Station Leaders then report to the Quartermaster for station supplies and Walking Leaders to your banner post in the gathering area. Please take time to carefully review your leadership manual for instructions and helpful tips for the day. Walking Leaders ****Very Important **** remember to bring ice and an extra cooler each day. We will supply only ONE cooler for each walking den and NO ice! Please make your arrangements ahead of time!!

We have two Mandatory Leadership Trainings! Please plan to attend both. The first is June 8, 2017 at the Lake Holm LDS Building (Roundtable location) 19107 SE Lake Holm Rd, Auburn, WA 98092. 7:00 pm. All compliance forms and youth protection training certificates will be due to your camp pack coordinator by this date. The second training will be on July 10, 2017 7:00 pm at Auburn Game Farm Park Wilderness. Please leave your cubs home during both trainings.

A few reminders:

- The cubs will look to you for leadership. Always wear a smile and speak with kindness and respect.
- Please do not ever be alone with a scout, even your own son.
- If you are taking medicines while at camp, please do so at headquarters.
- Discipline is your responsibility when at camp. If a camper is getting out of control and walking/station leadership needs help - let the Camp Director help at Headquarters.
- Please silence your cell phones during camp. They are very distracting to the scouts and distract you from watching/helping the boys. Also, no chairs/magazines, etc., during station time. This is your opportunity to be involved with the cubs, having fun and helping them do THEIR BEST!

Please bring:

1. Sack lunch (in a Ziploc) and a water bottle filled with water – with your name on it.
2. Bring your smile, sense of humor, and enthusiasm. This is a wonderful opportunity for you!!
3. Good shoes – CLOSE TOED. You will be on your feet all day.
4. Dress for the weather and with modesty. You will be very active during the day, be aware of your clothing and the youth that will be around you.
