

Dear Pack Coordinators,

Thank you in advance for your hard work the next few months as you work on day camp. The day camp committee is really looking forward to this July and have many fun things planned. Please let us know if you have any questions regarding camp registration. We would be happy to help you! Below is a brief summary of registration, staffing needs at camp, and the training schedule. Please ask if you have any questions!



1) As we did last year, registration is completely online – Everything will still center around the Foothills District Cub Camp Webpage – www.foothillscubdaycamp.webs.com. As a pack coordinator, please go online and create an account. (Even if you had an account last year, you will need to create one again.) Once you created an account, please email us so we can give you pack coordinator privileges and the ability to see all the registrations and their status within your pack.

Registration will be done by the family online, then you will have access to all the records both youth and adult, to change and update. It is a similar registration as last year. Cub registrations will be due April 11th.

2) All packs need to supply 1 station leader per day (Tuesday thru Friday) for every 8 scouts or part thereof they are sending to camp. All packs need to supply 1 walking leader per day (Tuesday thru Friday) for every 4 scouts or part thereof. Please tally wolves, bears, and webelos separate, as they rotate differently. All packs need to supply 2 volunteers for set up at camp on Monday 2:00 – 6:00 pm and 2 volunteers 1:00 to 4:00 pm for take down at camp on Friday. Friday's take down staff should not have "car pool" responsibilities. Monday set up and Friday take down staffing is in addition to the staffing required for camp. Schedules are due by May 9th.

3) All walking leaders, station leaders, camp aides, and den chiefs need to attend the mandatory June 13, 2019 training meeting, 7:00 pm during Roundtable. Please remind your volunteers of this fact often, so everyone has it on their calendars. Our camp success is in part based on an educated and enthusiastic staff! All volunteers need to know this information to be able to help the cubs "do their best". If ALL volunteer schedules are turned in on time in May, we will have volunteer assignments available at the June meeting.

4) Mandatory onsite Training Meeting for all volunteers is scheduled for the Monday, July 8, 2019, 7:00 pm - GFWP. Please be on time so we can get all the information covered quickly. Finalized staff assignments will be available that night. Bring a chair or something to sit on please.

5) Any staff wishing to assist in the Archery or BB ranges will need to attend the Chief Seattle Council Shooting Sports Training. Date TBA (May – June). Please contact us for more information. Any Boy Scouts (14 and older only) wanting to participate in these stations must attend the training yearly. Proof of current certification will be required for any volunteer manning the shooting ranges.

7) We need lots of Boy Scouts. If you know of some, recruit them to come to camp.
